INPP UK (International)

Originator of the Method
Training in the INPP Method Worldwide

1. Administer Licentiate membership for INPP practitioners within the UK or other countries if no National Principal has been appointed
2. Provision of bi-annual supervision days for Licentiates

Licences National Principals to provide the above

National Principals

Licence qualified practitioners to provide training in:

1. Assessing Neuromotor Readiness for Learning
2. Screening for NMI in Children and Adults (Clinician's course)

Licensed by INPP UK to:

1. Provide the three training courses specified above in the INPP Method
2. Administer Licentiate membership within the territory

Principal's Private Clinical Practice

INPP Licentiates

1. Completed the INPP practitioner course
2. Hold a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in a subject allied to Education, Medicine or Psychology
3. Renew Licentiate membership annually with INPP National Principal (code of ethics available on request)
4. Attend a minimum of two biannual supervision (CPD) days with National Principal or INPP International
5. Practice as independent practitioners responsible for all the aspects of their own practice
6. INPP only recommends practitioners who are current INPP Licentiates
